INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILTER STRIP APPLICATION

- Owner must be the current owner of record as indicated in the records of St. Joseph County
- 2. List all parcel I.D.'s affected by the legal description
- 3. List the name of the ditch, regulated drain, or stream
- Legal description must be prepared by the St. Joseph County Surveyor or a Professional Surveyor licenses in good standing in the State of Indiana. Description shall contain acres.
- A plat of the parcel(s) shall be attached. Plat shall be 8 ½" x 11" in size. The plat need not be a specific scale but must be clear, neat, legible, clearly delineating course with bearings and dimensions.
- Attach an aerial photo copy with the proposed parcel(s) clearly highlighted or delineated
- 7. Attach documentation of property's most current assessed value
- Attach a letter of acceptance of filter strip classification from the St. Joseph County Soil and Water Conservation District

Site 1 is a channelized agriculture drainage ditch that runs through a small marsh complex before draining into Skinner Lake. This site sees consistently high levels of phosphorus, suspended solids, & turbidty due to lack of agricultural conservation practices upstream. Installation of filter strips and conservation farming practices upstream would benefit water quality at this site.
